

2K Polymer Systems Limited Privacy Statement

This Privacy Statement (the "Statement" or "Privacy Statement") applies to personal information that 2K Polymer Systems Ltd., together with its subsidiaries and affiliates (collectively, "2K Polymer Systems," "us," "we," or "our") collects. This includes information collected via our website (https://www.2kps.net/ referred to herein as "Website").

This Statement applies to information we collect on/via the Website, whether you use the Website via a computer, mobile device, or any other platform or equipment.

It does <u>not</u> apply to information collected by us offline or through any other means, including on any other website by 2K Polymer Systems or any third party (including our affiliates and subsidiaries); or any third party, including through any application or content (including advertisement) that may link to or be accessible from or on the Website.

A. TYPE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION COLLECTED AND HOW IT IS COLLECTED

When you visit our Website we may collect personal information such as:

We use information that we collect about you or that you provide us, including any personal information, for or in connection with:

- Our contracted service providers that process personal information on our behalf.
- Affiliates within our current or future corporate group that process personal information for customer support, marketing, event management, technical operations and account management.
- Third-party networks and websites so that we can advertise on their platforms.
- Parties in connection with a merger or acquisition of our business.
- Public and government authorities, to the extent we are compelled to disclose personal data to comply with our legal obligations.

C. DISCLOSURE OF YOUR INFORMATION

We may disclose aggregated information about our users, and information that does not identify any individual, without restriction.

We may disclose information that we collect or you provide as described in this Privacy Statement:

- To comply with any court order, law, or legal process, including to respond to any governmental or regulatory request.
